Job title: Voluntary Member

Hours: Flexible, minimum 5 hours per month

Role:

Assisting with the restoration and maintenance of various WWII fortifications around the island of Guernsey. This may include but not limited to gardening, painting, small building projects and general maintenance to ensure the upkeep of the sites.

We meet on Tuesday evenings and Saturday mornings at one of the sites, working as a group to restore and maintain these important fortifications. Volunteering is very flexible, members can choose whether to assist on a Tuesday night or Saturday morning, or both, whatever works best for them. It is also not essential that members are on site every week.

We are looking for enthusiastic people with a good sense of humour, who are happy to roll up their sleeves and get “stuck in” to whatever is required. An interest in the Occupation during WWII and/or a building trade or engineering background is welcomed but not essential. Our aim is to make available to the public, visiting historic societies and academics examples of the most important fortifications built in Guernsey by the German occupying forces between 1940-45.

Due to insurance requirements, we are unable to consider anyone under the age of 16 for these roles.
